The PCS National Black Members' Committee is marking the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Windrush with a Facebook Live and Zoom event taking place on **Monday, 19 June at 6pm -7.30pm.**

The event will reflect on the Windrush legacy and scandal which has impacted so many black people and their families. The scandal highlighted deep-rooted issues of racism and discrimination within the UK immigration system. The Windrush generation, named after the ship that brought the first wave of Caribbean immigration to the UK in 1948, faced systematic barriers to citizenship and employment opportunities for decades, despite their contribution to the country's economy and society.

PCS continues to call for justice for the Windrush generation and their descendants and crucially for compensation to be paid to those impacted, as many victims have still not yet been compensated.
