Support striking courts staff

OCS security officers start four days strike action tomorrow (22) and will hold picket lines at courts across England and Wales.

Security officers employed by OCS in 149 courts across England and Wales will start a <u>four-day strike over pay tomorrow (22)</u>. The strike action has been called following the company's latest pay offer which is only 38p above the national minimum wage.

Some courts have already announced they will be closed tomorrow, with more expected to follow suit as staff fail to turn up for work on 22, 25, 27 and 29 September.
