# HMRC Inland Pre-Clearance: Industrial action ballot result

Inland Pre-Clearance members meet the legal threshold and vote overwhelmingly for action. PCS continues to hold talks with HMRC and will keep members informed.

## **Ballot result**

The ballot result for the Inland Pre-Clearance industrial action ballot is as follows:

### Q1: "ARE YOU PREPARED TO TAKE PART IN STRIKE ACTION?"

- 1. Number of individuals entitled to vote in the ballot: 62
- 2. Number of Votes Cast: 38
- 3. Number of "YES" Votes: 35 (94.59%)
- 4. Number of "NO" Votes: 2 (5.41%)
- 5. Number of spoiled or otherwise invalid voting papers: 1

### Q2: "ARE YOU PREPARED TO TAKE PART IN INDUSTRIAL ACTION SHORT OF A STRIKE?"

- 1. Number of individuals entitled to vote in the ballot: 62
- 2. Number of Votes Cast: 38
- 3. Number of "YES" Votes: 38 (100%)
- 4. Number of "NO" Votes: 0
- 5. Number of spoiled or otherwise invalid voting papers: 0

The number of votes cast in the ballot comfortably meets the minimum 50% turnout, which is required by law for an industrial action ballot to be successful.
