# Get involved at the Proud Extraordinary General Meeting

The meeting will debate motions on the future of Proud, PCS's LGBT+ committee, and hold elections.

To improve engagement with our LGBT+ members and to take forward a motion passed at conference, the Proud national committee (PNC) will hold an extraordinary general meeting (EGM) on Wednesday 13 December from 6-7:30 pm on Zoom.

At our annual conference this year, [motion A293 was passed](#), instructing the national executive committee to ask all members to update their equality data on our membership database and register for membership of Proud and the other national equality networks. LGBT+ members were then to be invited to an Extraordinary General Meeting to debate the future of Proud as well as allowing for the election of a new Proud National Committee.
