Timetable for PCS Conferences and Elections

- Thursday 25 April Group elections open
- Thursday 9 May National elections closes at noon
- Friday 10 May National election results will be issued
- Tuesday 14 May Group elections close at noon
- Wednesday 15 May Group election results will be issued
- Monday 20 May Group conferences begin
- Tuesday 21 May National conference begins
- Thursday 23 May National conference closes.
