Our pensions case against the government will be heard in the Court of Appeal on 20 February and we are to launch a judicial review to challenge the anti-union Strikes (Minimum Service Levels) Act 2023.

In our workplaces we have a network of trained reps who can provide help and support with workplace issues and also wider issues that have an impact in the workplace, such as mental health or domestic violence. HeartUnions week is a time to celebrate the contribution made by our reps who volunteer their own time to help others.
