Still time for branches to order national ballot materials

Branches can still order materials to encourage as many members as possible to vote in our ballot for strike action.

It's vital that we return a strong YES vote in our national ballot to tell the government that we've had enough of attacks on our pay, pensions and jobs.

A strong yes vote tells the government that we're ready to fight for our demands of:

- a cost-of-living rise, with an inflation-proofed increase plus pay restoration
- pay equality across departments
- a living wage of £15 per hour
- London weighting provision of a minimum £5,000 per year
- 35 days annual leave minimum
- a significant shortening of the working week with no loss of pay
